

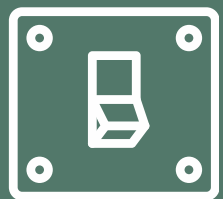
Electrical Fire Safety

Plugs



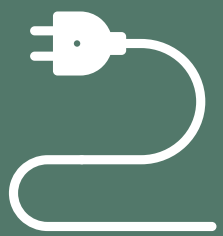
DON'T overload plug sockets. Having too many items plugged in at once can lead to overheating.

Switches



ALWAYS switch off your appliances when you are not using them. Ask your accommodation team about arranging for your personal electrical items to be PAT Tested.

Wires



DON'T run wires under mats and keep away from hot surfaces. Make sure to check the conditions of your wires regularly. Ask your accommodation team about arranging for your personal electrical items to be PAT Tested.

European Safety Mark



CHECK for the British or European safety mark when buying your electrical appliances.

Electric Scooters



Electrical scooters and bikes are prohibited.

Turn off



AVOID leaving electrical appliances on overnight that do not need to be.

Overcharging



AVOID charging electrical products such as laptops and phones throughout the night.

Hair Straighteners



DON'T leave straighteners on and make sure they are placed on a heatproof matt.

Electrical Chargers



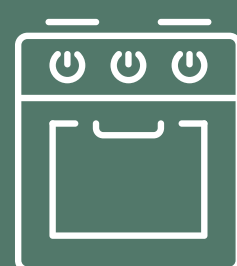
DON'T use counterfeit chargers, make sure they are from legitimate sources.

Foreign Appliances



DON'T use foreign appliances in UK sockets if they have not been converted for UK use.

Kitchen Appliances



NEVER leave kitchen appliances like oven, kettles etc on overnight. Make sure it is switched off and unplugged.
